

# Libby Lehman: Two for One Thread Play

## Supplies:

- Sewing machine in good working order
- Extra Bobbin case and bobbins
- Basic sewing supplies
- \*# 29 Free-Motion Foot and/or BSR Foot
- \*#20 or #20C or #20D Open Toe Embroidery Foot
- Pencil and paper
- \*Scissors
- Surge Protector and long extension cord
- \*#90 topstitch needles
- \*#75 Quilting or #70 Microtex or Jeans/Denim
- Any decorative threads you want to use, including thicker bobbin threads
- \*The Bottom Line or similar fine bobbin thread (do not use Sulky Bobbin Lite)
- \*Polyester monofilament (MonoPoly)
- Yarns or trims for couching
- \*Threadplay with Libby Lehman (optional)
- Cushion for chair (optional)
- Sheer fabrics for embellishment (fun but not mandatory)
- \*Circular Embroidery Attachment (optional)
- \*#43 Free Motion Couching Foot (optional)
- Any embellishments that tickle your fancy



## Fabric Requirements:

- \*2 pieces of 18” square medium-heavyweight TearAway stabilizer or Rinsaway washaway by HTCW
- \*½ yard fusible web, such as Wonder Under by Pellon
- \*At least two 14” square pieces of cotton batting
- \*505 temporary spray adhesive
- \*Small bottle of Roxane’s Glue-Baste-It
- \*2 fat quarters that play well together, but have some contrast. You can bring the equivalent in scraps, but make sure they are at least 14” square
