Supplies:

Sewing machine in good working order

Basic sewing supplies

*Thread for piecing

*Thread for topstitching

*#37 foot

*The Abbey Bag pattern

*6-1/2" x 24" ruler

Freezer paper

Paper and Pencil

*Fabric Glue (Unique Stitch) works great,

I will bring craft sand if any one wants any of it.

Your favorite Quilting tool

Circle Cutter (optional)

Fabric Requirements:

1 Charm pack or (8) 5" x 5" pieces for Pin Cushion and (2) 5" x 5" pieces for bag pocket

1 Fat Quarter - outside of bag & connector

1 Fat Quarter - Inside of bag

1 Fat Quarter – Top Band & Flower

1 piece of fabric 12" x 12" for inside of pin cushion,

1/3 yard Fusible Fleece

1 1-1/4" button

I will bring poly fill for everyone to use you may use Sand, or Emmy or Crush Walnuts

5" x 5" piece of Rubberized shelf liner

Cutting Instructions before class as follows:

Make sure you LABEL everything you cut

5" x 5" pieces for Pin Cushions

You will cut these in class, you will need a total of 8 of them

Bag Pocket

Cut 2 pieces 4" x 5" pieces from the (2) 5" x 5" pieces for the pocket

1 Fat Quarter – outside of bag & connector

Cut 1 piece 9' x 20" for outside of bag

Cut 1 piece 9" x 9-1/2" for outside of bag

Cut 2 pieces 5" x 6" for connectors

1 Fat Quarter – inside of bag

Cut 2 pieces 9" x 9-1/2" for inside of bag

1 Fat Quarter – top band and flower

Cut 1 piece 5" x 19" for top and of bag

Cut 2 pieces 9-1/2" x 9-1/2" for flower

Lining fabric or Muslin

Cut 1 piece 12" square for inside of pin cushion

1/3 yard fusible fleece

Cut 1 piece 9' x 9-1/2" for inside of bag

Cut 1 piece 9-1/2" x 9-1/2" for flower

Rubberized shelf Liner

You will cut in class
